Political contributions **must** be made from personal funds. Contributions from union treasuries cannot be accepted. **Also, we are unable to accept contributions from Federal PAC Funds due to the Federal Election Commission limits.** Personal checks should be made payable to the "Political Educational Fund of NABTU."

If you elect to send your political educational fund contribution by mail, please send it to NABTU by **Friday, March 20, 2020**.

**2020 – GOVERNING BOARD of PRESIDENTS' CLUB:** Delegates who provide the full delegate and voluntary political education contribution will be included in the Governing Board of Presidents' Club. Club members will receive a special memento and an entry form for the 2020 Legislative Conference Sweepstakes, giving club members the opportunity to participate in multiple drawings for sweepstakes gifts.
