

## **NABTU COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL**

In the event the District of Columbia lifts any of its safety protocols, NABTU will continue to require masking and proof of vaccination for all indoor events.

### **D.C. Vaccination Entry Requirement:**

Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2021-148, to enter the hotel and participate in the conference, guests and visitors 12 years and older **must be fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 and demonstrate proof of such vaccination upon entry. Being "fully vaccinated" means that you have received the second dose of a two-dose series, or one dose of a single-dose vaccine. For proof of vaccination, guests/visitors must provide one of the following three:

1. A CDC issued vaccination card (original, photocopy, or digital copy/photo),
2. Record of immunization from a healthcare provider or public health authority, or
3. A COVID-19 verification app (e.g., VaxYes, Clear, Excelsior, MyIR)

Guests/visitors who are 18 years and older must also provide a photo ID (e.g., driver's license, passport).

Guests/visitors who have and show documentation of medical or religious exemptions from the COVID-19 vaccine must provide a negative PCR or antigen test administered within the last 24 hours.

### **D.C. Mask Requirement:**

Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2021-147, everyone – including fully vaccinated people – must wear masks in indoor public settings, including common areas of hotels and hotel conference rooms.
