Bio

Charmaine Nembhard is a Bronx resident and one of the Laborers' Local 1010 union apprentices. Charmaine says that the opportunity to become a Union Laborer changed her life. Charmaine was born in Jamaica and emigrated to the U.S. with her family years ago. She learned about the Laborers' apprenticeship program through Pathways 2 Apprenticeship (P2A), a pre-apprenticeship program with the mission to recruit, train, and mentor community members from low-income communities specifically those in the re-entry community for life-long careers in the unionized construction industry. She says this experience led her to her home at Local 1010.

Charmaine said while she held only a few jobs in her life, being a union Laborer will allow her to provide for her family and plan for her future. Charmaine hopes others have the same opportunity to become an apprentice.



Why Charmaine Was Nominated

Charmaine Nembhard is a hard-working and dedicated apprentice at Laborers' Local 1010. Her leadership qualities are what make her stand out. She is a quick learner and does not lack humility. She undoubtedly makes the job site a more efficient and pleasant space.
