## Bio

My name is Naomi Lawson, I am 35 years old. I'm a disabled veteran and an Inside Wireman journeyman for IBEW Local Union 347 and have been in the trade for 10 years. Before the electrical trade, I was an Avionics Mechanic in the Army. I maintained and repaired Blackhawk helicopters which entailed electrical work involving flight controls, communications, and other various avionics systems.

Following a deployment to Afghanistan, I lost my husband to suicide which sadly is an overwhelming common loss among veterans. I decided to return home and start over with our son. I wanted to set an example of independence and capability for him. After losing my husband, I wanted the ability to fix things at home to avoid being swindled by companies and to be financially comfortable. I wanted to be able to learn something I could pass on to my son.

Since I had done some electrical work on aircraft, I wanted to be an electrician. With no idea of how to achieve that, I attended a local community college, following the Electrical Construction Trades degree program. I met a relative of an electrician from IBEW LU 347 who explained the apprenticeship to me, so I applied. Joining the union and completing the



apprenticeship was a great choice for me and my family. The pay, insurance, and retirement plans have provided a comfortable life for me and my son. I take every chance I get to promote the trades, especially to other veterans and women who have interest but are unsure. I'm proud to say I was the one who helped many of these folks find their way into unions in the metro and even some in other states.
