The **NABTU Tradeswomen Build Nations** (TWBN) conference is scheduled for September 27 - 29, 2024, in New Orleans, Louisiana, at the Hilton New Orleans Riverside / New Orleans Convention Center. This conference is the largest of its type in North America and offers tradeswomen the skills, resources, and support to thrive throughout their careers in the building trades. I am requesting the support of the Local to send tradeswomen and men to attend the conference.

This international conference is sponsored by North America's Building Trades Unions (NABTU) and has the support of every international building trades union. This is the 14th year of the TWBN, and the conference has grown to be the largest annual gathering of unionized tradeswomen globally with over 4,000 attendees.

TWBN brings together tradeswomen union apprentices, journey-level workers, leaders, and retirees to network, share experiences, mentor and learn. Government, industry, and labor leaders, apprenticeship and training coordinators, and tradeswomen from across the country attend and facilitate workshops, panels, and plenary sessions. The goal of the conference is to uplift tradeswomen in unions, promote recruitment and retention, strengthen leadership skills and union identity, and foster mentoring and support networks.
