**REGISTRATION AND HOTEL INFORMATION:** Conference registration and hotel room blocks will open on **Wednesday, January 22, 2025**. The registration fee for the conference is \$200 for each delegate. **Please note that all registrations must be completed online, as we are no longer accepting mail-in registration forms.** If you choose to pay by check, please do so no later than Friday, March 21, 2025, and [attach this form](#) dictating the names of whom the payment covers. Checks should be made payable to "North America's Building Trades Unions." As a reminder, the registration fee may be paid from union treasury funds or personal funds. We are unable to accept Federal PAC funds as registration payment.

**VOLUNTARY POLITICAL EDUCATION CONTRIBUTION:** We ask each delegate member of NABTU's affiliates or their executive and administrative personnel to make a voluntary \$150.00 contribution to the Political Education Fund of NABTU. The suggested \$150.00 contribution is only a suggestion. You may contribute a different amount, or no amount, without suffering any reprisal or adverse consequences. Contributions to the Political Education Fund are not tax deductible. The Political Educational Fund is a separate fund designed to support lawmakers who advance the goals of NABTU and its affiliates.

Political contributions **must** be made from personal funds. Contributions from union treasuries cannot be accepted. **Also, we are unable to accept contributions from Federal PAC Funds due to the Federal Election Commission limits.** Personal checks should be made payable to the "Political Educational Fund of NABTU."

If you elect to send your political educational fund contribution by mail, please send it to NABTU by **Friday, March 21, 2025**.

**2025 – GOVERNING BOARD of PRESIDENTS' CLUB:** Delegates who provide the full delegate and voluntary political education contribution will be included in the Governing Board of Presidents' Club. Club members will receive a memento and an entry form for the 2025 Legislative Conference Sweepstakes.

**2025 – LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE SWEEPSTAKES:** Delegates will have the opportunity to participate in the Legislative Conference Sweepstakes. In order to win one of the exclusive gifts, participants must be present during the Sweepstakes drawings. Examples of the gifts will be on display at the conference.
