In Kingsmill, we will have the opportunity to play two PGA courses, the River and Plantation, which are nestled alongside the James River and a few miles away from historic Williamsburg and Yorktown. Labor of Love will begin with an opening reception on Saturday evening, followed by Sunday's events (Welcome Reception, Poker Tournament, Masters Tournament, and various other activities), and conclude with Monday's Labor of Love tournament and awards ceremony.
