HEAT STROKE IS DEADLY KNOW THE SIGNS



WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

- Confusion, altered mental status, slurred speech
- Loss of consciousness
- Hot, dry skin or heavy sweating
- Seizures
- Very high body temperature
- Fatal if treatment delayed

HEAT STROKE CAN BE FATAL! <u>Don't wait.</u>

WHAT TO DO:

- Call 911 right away
- Stay with the worker
- Move to shade or a cool place
- Remove outer clothing
- Cool them down fast:
- 1. Use a cold water or ice bath if you can
- 2. Wet their skin or clothes with cool water
- 3. Put cold, wet cloths on the head, neck, armpits, and groin
- 4. Fan them to help cool faster
